Medicaid Redetermination: We Can Still Make a Difference

In March of 2023, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) informed the general public that the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency would end in May. According to DHS, between June 2023 and May 2024, more than 1.6 million Wisconsin members must renew their BadgerCare Plus or Medicaid benefits to avoid a gap in health coverage.

To-date, Wisconsin is lagging behind the rest of the United States in renewals, meaning many vulnerable Wisconsinites are losing health insurance. The largest wave of members up for renewal is still coming, slotted for March - June, 2024.

We hope you will join Molina and DHS in spreading the word to your Medicaid members that they must renew in order to keep their state insurance.
